The Opelika Chamber of Commerce was organized on January 13, 1941 and was incorporated on August 26 of that same year by Homer Carter, Yetta G. Samford, R.W. Williams, Edward M. Roberts, Jr., Winston Smith T, A.L. Screws, A.C. Tatum, D.W. Ward, John L. Whatley and John D. McKibben.

Many of these individuals' families are still in Opelika, contributing as much to the prosperity of the City as they once did. And while the faces have changed, the goal of the Opelika Chamber of Commerce largely remains the same.

As was recorded in the original Petition for Incorporation, the purpose is to "promote the commercial, industrial, agricultural and civic interests of the City of Opelika and the surrounding territory; to promote integrity and good faith, just and equitable principles in business..." In 1941, "annual dues were \$12 - minimum - payable quarterly."

OPELIKA – RICH IN HERITAGE WITH A VISION FOR THE FUTURE

pelika first appears on maps as far back as 1733. The earliest people in Opelika were the Creeks or Muskogee Indians. Early traders called them "Creeks" because of their habit of living along rivers and streams.

The first white settlers in the area now known as Opelika arrived in the late 1830s and established a community called Lebanon. After the removal of the native peoples by force in 1836-37, the area became known as "Opelika", taken from a word in the Muskogee language meaning "large swamp". Settlement was sporadic until the late 1840s, when Opelika quickly became a commercial center with the coming of the railroad.

In 1848, the Montgomery & West Point Railroad Company extended a rail line from Montgomery, Alabama to Opelika, and in 1851 completed a connection to West Point, Georgia, thus connecting Opelika with Atlanta, Georgia. This line was the only direct rail route between New Orleans and the Eastern Seaboard, and rapidly became one of the primary trade lines for shipments of raw cotton from Southern plantations to the North. The Montgomery & West Point lines were soon joined by a rail connection to Columbus, Georgia in 1855, and a connection to Birmingham, Alabama in 1869. Almost overnight, Opelika became a regional hub for commerce.

To manage this rapid growth, Opelika was incorporated as a town on February 9, 1854. As a result of Opelika's transportation infrastructure, many warehouses for storing cotton and other goods were built. With the onset of the Civil War these warehouses were converted to Confederate supply depots. In 1864 and 1865, Union raids commanded by Lovell Rousseau and James H. Wilson attacked Opelika, tearing up the railroads and destroying all government property, including Opelika's warehouses.

Soon after the end of the war, the Alabama state legislature created a new county out of parts of Macon, Russell, Chambers, and Tallapoosa counties to be named after Confederate general Robert E. Lee. In 1866, citizens of the new "Lee County" voted Opelika as the county seat, despite the fact that Opelika was technically unincorporated after having its charter revoked for abetting the rebellion against the United States.

After Opelika received a new charter in 1870, rapid growth

resumed. The town nearly doubled in size between 1870 and 1900. During this time, Opelika began to gain a reputation as a wild, lawless town. Soon after receiving the new charter, city officials attempted to scam outside investors by issuing fake railroad bonds. For this, the town's charter was revoked again in 1872, and the town was administered as a police district by the state legislature for the following year. Opelika's downtown was packed with saloons, and frequent gunfire in the streets led to railroads ordering passengers passing through Opelika to duck beneath the windows to avoid being shot.

In 1882, voters dismissed the incumbent city government. Unwilling to give up power, the city council nullified the election until the courts ruled against them. When the state yet again revoked Opelika's charter, the city leaders took up arms against those that opposed them, and the governor was forced to send in the militia to restore order. Opelika remained under unelected military rule for sixteen years until 1899, when Opelika's charter was again restored.

In 1900, local investors founded the Opelika Cotton Mill as the first textile plant in the city, employing 125. In 1925 Pepperell Manufacturing Co. constructed a large mill just outside of the Opelika city limits. The period between 1930 and 1970 would turn out to be Opelika's heyday, as industrial growth turned Opelika into a regional economic powerhouse.

Opelika continued to add factories and other industry throughout the middle years of the twentieth century. In the 1950s, Opelika attracted the nation's first and largest magnetic tape manufacturing plant. In 1963, tire manufacturer Uniroyal constructed a massive plant in Opelika, and around the same time Diversified Products revolutionized the physical fitness equipment industry with products produced in their Opelika plant. By the early 1970s, Opelika's industries employed nearly 10,000.

Between the late 1970s and 2005, non-agricultural employment in the Auburn-Opelika area grew at a slow but steady pace. By the late 1990s, Opelika sought to



increase its industrial employment base by purchasing and developing a 2,200 acre park site, Northeast Opelika Industrial Park. Since 1999, two major distribution centers, four tier 1 automotive suppliers and one manufacturer of dietary supplements have located within the park. In 2003, the park was recognized as one of the "South's Best Automotive Assembly Plant Sites" by Southern Business & Development, an industry trade publication.

Opelika has also experienced a boom in retail development. Conveniently located at the intersection of Interstate 85 and Highway 280, Tiger Town, a 130- acre mixed use development, has nearly one million square feet of retail space as well as freestanding restaurants, banks, offices, and hotel sites. It is east Alabama's largest retail center and is home to more than 85 businesses.


Across the interstate from Tiger Town, sits the AMC Tiger 13 Cinema which boasts of having the largest screen in the nation.

Following major renovations, Historic Downtown Opelika

is enjoying a return to the center of life in Opelika. The shopping and restaurant district has been improved with a turn of the 20th century flair. Opelika is filled with a variety of specialty shops, galleries, antique stores, restaurants, breweries, a distillery and a speakeasy. The John Emerald Distilling Company and the Red Clay Brewery have won numerous awards in their fields.

Wanting to keep up with future technology for businesses and homes, Opelika invested in the fiber optic system and became Alabama's first "Gig City" which means she has one of the most advanced, high-tech 100% fiber optic systems in the world! There is almost no limit to what can be done with fiber technology. In 2018, the City sold the fiber portion to Point Broadband.

Opelika might have started out a little rocky with people ducking as they rode through, but today people flock to this charming, progressive and lively city. Come for a visit. Stay for a lifetime.

THEWHITFIELD-DUKE-SEARCY HOME

ow home to the Opelika Chamber of Commerce, the Whitfield-Duke-Searcy Home, a Victorian, was built by the John Whitfield family in 1895. They sold the Victorian home to Judge Duke and his family in 1902. The Whitfields, then moved to Montgomery and opened the ALGA Syrup Company and the Whitfield Pickle Company. In 1903, the pocket doors were installed. In 1932, gas furnaces were installed.

Mrs. Inez Duke Searcy, Judge Duke's daughter and the second female attorney in our state, moved her family into the home in the late thirties/early forties. She entertained, raised her children and enjoyed living in the home until 1979.

In 1979, First Alabama Bank purchased the Searcy home for their Opelika office. In 1988, the City of Opelika bought the building from the bank to house the Chamber of Commerce.

All of the pocket doors are original to the house. The alcove under the stairs was home to a "swooning couch." The conference room was originally the formal dining room and closer to the kitchen was the breakfast room. There were also pocket doors between the parlor and dining room, and there is a slight recess there now. The bank had installed a teller line where the doors had been.

The downstairs rooms were bedrooms for guests. The kitchen remains in the same location. The upstairs housed the family sleeping quarters.

All of the mantles are original to the home as is the inside woodwork. The front room mantle is made of birds-eye maple. The stairwell is original, but it has been painted. All of the leaded glass windows in the house are original, including the one on the upper wall above the stairs and below the stairwell, which was used to brighten the dark corner below the stairs. There was a barn at the site of the drive through.

SALES TAX RATE Opelika Sales 9.0% and Use Tax



THE ART HAUS – MAKING A DIFFERENCE NOPELIKA

hen Opelika native Henry J. Stern died in 2014, he left a part of his estate with instructions to his two children to use the funds for one purpose and one purpose only: to make a positive difference in his beloved hometown.





J. and Ginger have done just that. They have honored their family name in a number of ways, including Stern Park, the renovation of the Rocky Brook train at Municipal Park, investments in local businesses and now, their newest venture, the Art Haus.

To honor their mother, Roslyn Stern, who taught art for decades, both in the Opelika City Schools system and privately, the brother and sister team purchased a former church and two adjacent houses to provide working studio space, a gallery to create and display artworks, a teaching area to offer educational opportunities for children and adults, as well as housing quarters for artists. "We did a soft opening by hosting the school system's Superintendent's Art Show and then held two small, private art classes," Ginger said. "We also have a group of ladies, The Studio Sisters, who meet regularly to create their art and two local artists are currently working in our space."

When all three phases of the project are complete, Art Haus will have seven studios that can be rented by local and visiting artists.

To make their vision come to life, J. and Ginger partnered with awardwinning architect Behzad Nakhjavan to renovate the original church building.

"We let Behzad do whatever he wanted to do, with basically one request, to utilize as much of the original 1,600 square foot structure as possible," Ginger said. "He found incredibly creative ways to do that, including repurposing beams from the ceilings into the beautiful, heart pine flooring."

The open-air back patio is paved with bricks retrieved from the original Pepperell Mill on First Avenue, adding not only an artistic flare, but also reusing a part of Opelika's history.

"We have a very creative board of directors who want to continue to expand the capabilities, offerings and purpose of Art Haus," J. said.

Art Haus is just the most recent way the Henry J. Stern Foundation is making a difference in Opelika and leaving their family's legacy. Don't miss an opportunity to visit this treasure.



GOGUE PERFORMING ARTS CENTER PROVIDES WORLD-CLASS EXPERIENCES IN YOUR BACKYARD

he Jay and Susie Gogue Performing Arts Center first opened its doors in August 2019 as the center launched its inaugural season with touring Broadway productions, opera, dance and musical performances and student and faculty music and theater performances.

The facility itself is a first for Lee County, Alabama, featuring the 1,202-seat Woltosz Theatre and 3,500-capacity Amphitheatre at the City of Auburn Lawn and Porch, with 17,000 square feet of open space for outdoor performances and events, according to Auburn Opelika Tourism.

Since it's opening, the center has kept busy with 12 shows in 2019 and 18 shows in spring 2020. Patrons are sure to find a show that interests them, says Gogue Center Executive Director Christopher Heacox.

"What we're hearing from our audiences is the sense that variety, diversity of programming, and the quality has been quite phenomenal and exciting," Heacox says.

Many of the performances at the Gogue Center are normally not found in an area the size of Lee County, which is part of what makes the center so special. There are many performances that only visit larger cities that are now coming to the Gogue Center, which has brought in many locals and out-of-state guests.

There has been a lot of excitement throughout the area for the performances and the Gogue Center itself. Heacox states the center has seen many patrons taking a chance on new performances and often enjoying them.

"The feedback in regards to artists that have never come to this community (who are well-known or world-class or whatever superlative you want to say), gives the community a sense of pride that these... artists, these individuals, these performances are here in our community... not only performing for audiences on stage but giving back... on campus and in our communities," Heacox says.

"The Gogue Center hosts activities throughout the year including school performances for area elementary, middle and high schools. Students often





OHS CULINARY PROGRAM OFFERS STUDENTS A BIG ADVANTAGE

pelika High School's (OHS) Culinary program is a step ahead of teaching students a new set of skills. Leading this forefront is Judy Eldred, with over 20 years experience, who is setting a new way to look at the future.

Eldred teaches the program with the goal of giving students more opportunities. Her culinary background is from the Orlando Culinary Academy. She has worked in various restaurant environments from Disney World, The Marriott, to owning her own bakery, and now teaching students. Through the OHS program "the students have a leadership skill set whether they use it or not that will benefit them in any position," said Eldred. Inspiring and preparing students for everyday life, with not only cooking skills but leadership skills, is a goal for her.

The program was established in 2015 and has grown exponentially, changing the path for many students. The program consists of four courses comprised of students 9th through 12th grade. The first course of the program is Hospitality and Tourism and that leads into Culinary Arts I. The basics of cooking are taught in these classes. Eldred



teaches the basics so that she can feel confident that after her students leave the program they are ready for any work environment. Once the students complete Culinary I the students can get certified in The Guest Service Gold and ServSafe Manager programs. Both these certifications put the students ahead in the work force, allowing them to move up and advance their careers faster.

If the students want to continue to grow their knowledge in this course, there are two different routes that can be taken. One path is Culinary II, which teaches the four mother sauces of cooking and more advanced cooking techniques. The other option is Baking & Pastry Arts. The students in this course will learn how to decorate and master the skill of baking. If the students continue their education in this course work, they are eligible during their senior year to participate in a CO-OP program that finds them work right out of high school. The longer the student is in the program, the more their knowledge grows as well as other leadership skills.

This Culinary program is one of a kind, teaching students to grow in a skill that sets them apart. Not only does this program go in depth about different cooking techniques, it makes students learn how to be a team member, how to multi-task, and learn management skills. The program has and will continue to grow and make an impact in students' lives by giving them a big advantage in the culinary community.



OPELIKA NEIGHBORHOOD MOBILE WELLNESS CLINIC SET TO LAUNCH SPRING 2020

his spring, the Opelika Neighborhood Mobile Wellness Clinic is set to hit the road, offering free health care and services to citizens in underserved areas.

Discussions of creating a mobile clinic in Opelika span back to the conception of the Carver-Jeter Master Plan that was drawn up in 2014, according to City Administrator Joey Motley. With the donation of a bus to the City of Opelika from the Auburn-based transportation service First Transit in 2018, that idea advanced one step closer toward reality.

A partnership including the City of Opelika, East Alabama Medical Center, Auburn University and Casey Family Programs was soon formed to help bring this project to life. The city agreed to bear the responsibility of upkeep and storage for the vehicle, while EAMC will oversee its day-to-day operations.

For further understanding on how a project like this could work in Opelika, representatives travelled to the University of Florida in Gainesville to meet with Dr. Nancy Hardt, who operates a similar mobile wellness clinic in her community. Coming away with a better understanding of how a project like this could work in Opelika, the city hired Mobile Studios to help conceptualize the project.

After blueprints were finished,

estimations put the cost of retrofitting the bus at nearly \$200,000. Motley said the city decided to create a fundraiser to help raise the monies needed instead of using taxpayer dollars, and that he along with Community Relations Officer Leigh Krehling and Revenue Officer Lillie Finley helped promote the project. "We appeared at community events and spoke with local businesses, social clubs, Sunday School classes ... really to anyone who would listen to us and hear what we wanted to do," Motley said.

Several local businesses and organizations stepped up to the plate to help meet more than half of that goal, with the Opelika Housing Authority, Opelika Rotary Club, AuburnBank and BBVA Compass donating a combined \$105,000. After securing the rest of the necessary funding, the bus was shipped to Greensboro, North Carolina, where it is currently being retrofitted by Matthews Specialty Vehicles. Once completed, the vehicle will be equipped with a waiting area, exam room, lavatory with sink and secure records room, among other features. Motley explained that EAMC will be

in charge of determining the clinic's location and staffing it with employees and medical sciences/nursing students from Auburn University and Southern Union State Community College.

While services will be determined by the hospital based on community needs and feedback, Motley said the goal is to provide citizens of all ages in underserved areas with basic exams, immunizations and other services free-ofcharge to create healthier communities and build lasting relationships.

"As a city, we think that this is an opportunity for people in underserved areas to receive quality care that they might not get anywhere else. We're excited about this and the impact that we think this will have in Opelika for years to come," Motley said.

The bus is expected to be finished in the coming weeks. Krehling is working with designers to put final touches on its outward artwork and graphics.

TOP-NOTCH POLICE OFFICERS GET TOP-NOTCH FACILITY

or the first time in 52 years, the Opelika Police Department has a new place to call home. Construction on the new facility, built adjacent to the former building, began in summer 2018 with the police department taking possession in fall 2019.

Every aspect of the new building is a vast improvement from the old one, which had not been added on or renovated since 1977. Larger, high-tech meeting rooms, a more accommodating layout and state-of-the-art equipment and technology give Opelika officers and staff a more inviting, conducive and efficient work environment.

"The architects went with us through every square inch of our old building," Opelika Police Chief John McEachern said. "They looked at what we had, listened carefully as we expressed our needs and then incorporated everything we asked for."

One of the highlights of the new building is a large patrol debriefing and meeting room. In the old department, there was not a room that could seat more than 20 officers at one time, but in the new building, the state-of-the-art space comfortably accommodates seating for more than 100, so the entire department can meet together in one room. It also affords opportunities to host events.

"With the technology and other upgraded features, we can facilitate 2-3 day seminars, trainings and other meetings for our staff as well as other departments



around the state," McEachern said. "It will be one of the most utilized areas of the building; we have already benefited from that space and will continue to use it in so many ways."

An evidence room allows the detective division to process collected items in an area specially designed with the equipment and tools they need. Other features include a fully equipped gym for workouts, larger, updated locker rooms that give officers an area to change and to store personal items and an improved break room that gives them a place to relax or grab a bite to eat. Windows throughout offices and hallways let in natural light and give the building a welcome and open feel. Security systems have been implemented throughout the facility to ensure safety, including video cameras to monitor movement and access cards required to enter every area of the building.

Separated from police operations for the first time, the municipal court facility has its own parking and entrance for those handling legal matters through the court. Those with law enforcement business park and enter the police department through the doors in the front of the building, facing South Tenth Street, while those going to municipal court will park and enter off of Martin Luther King Boulevard.

Another new and exciting feature is the addition of top-notch housing for the department's K-9s. "We will now have heated and cooled kennels that allow our officers to leave their service dogs at the department on their off days, where they will be treated royally. The K9 area will feature both indoor and outdoor runs for exercise," McEachern said. "The ground cover will be an astroturf-type material that includes an automatic drainage system in each kennel.

"We are really excited about the K9 area," McEachern said. "Our service dogs will be treated like the heroes they are."

In addition to their new facility, Opelika Mayor Gary Fuller announced in 2019 that Opelika police officers would receive pay raises to bring their salaries to a range that is among the highest in the state.

STATE-OF-THE-ART SPENCER CANCER CENTER OFFERS WORLD-CLASS TREATMENT

n June 2019, East Alabama Medical Center opened the doors of the E.L. Spencer, Jr. and Ruth Priester Spencer Cancer Center, with a goal to accommodate the needs of a growing community and provide a higher quality of care for patients.







Named after a former EAMC board chairman and his wife, the \$39.7-million, 59,596-square-foot facility located at 2501 Village Professional Drive is projected to treat 15,000 or more patients annually. The hospital's original cancer center was built in 1992,



but ran out of space for expansion, necessitating the need for a new facility.

With picturesque views of grassy fields and a wooded area outside, the facility's design and openness was designed with "the patient in mind," said EAMC's Director of Facilities



Jay Walters on a media tour.

"The majority of the land is back behind us, and we kept that very natural," Walters said. "We wanted (patients) to be able to see out, and we wanted to let a lot of light in." This new facility has 38 patient

infusion chairs, 12 exam rooms, four physician offices, high-dose rate room, laboratory and PET/CT simulator suite. On the facility's first floor is the radiation oncology department. Upstairs is the medical oncology department, pharmacy and boutique which includes accessories and clothing designed specifically for oncology patients, part of the hospital's goal to meet any individual's needs all from one location.

An often overlooked component of the facility is its chapel, which splits off from the main lobby.

Drugs meet a physical need, but we needed a space for spiritual needs as well," said Chris Clark, vice president of clinical services at the center, in a November interview with Birmingham Medical News. "Patients and family members can go there for some quiet time."

Though the center is relatively new, several positive reviews have been left on Google.

PICKLEBALL

One of America's Fastest Growing Sports

ickleball enthusiasts from Florida, Arizona, Michigan, New York and everywhere in between have flocked to Opelika, Alabama, to see the new courts constructed at the Opelika SportsPlex and Aquatics Center. However, there are still people in the Opelika community who are asking "What is pickleball?"

Pickleball is a paddle sport that combines elements of tennis, badminton and ping-pong. Players use paddles to volley the ball similar to a whiffle ball across a badminton sized court and slightly modified tennis net.

Casey Soule, President of the Opelika-Auburn Pickleball Club, said the game is pretty easy to learn. With one or two lessons beginners are typically ready to go. It can develop into a very competitive game, with players attending tournaments and becoming rated in the sport.

The Opelika-Auburn Pickleball Club has more than 200 members who play at the Opelika SportsPlex regularly. Many members are from Opelika and Auburn, as the name would suggest, but there are also many players from Phenix City, Valley, Lagrange, Montgomery, Columbus, Newnan and beyond. A few times a month a van from Birmingham pulls up with around 8 players to play Saturday morning games.

So, what is all the hype about? Not only is pickleball one of the world's fastest growing sports, but Opelika has also built a facility that is unlike any other facility in America. The Opelika Pickleball Facility features 12 state-of-the-art pickleball courts that are individually fenced, allowing for tournament style play. The entire facility is covered by a large canopy that offers shade and protection from the elements and features LED lighting for nighttime play. Because the facility is situated directly behind

the Opelika SportsPlex, players have access to ample parking, bathrooms, lockers, showers and concessions.

What's more, Opelika's pickleball courts are open to the public. Players do not have to be a member of the Opelika SportsPlex in order to play. The courts are also open 24-7. The Opelika-Auburn Pickleball Club and Parks and Recreation staff even offer free lessons and clinics to new players, and the players are diverse.

"The thing about pickleball is it is a very social sport," said Sam Bailey, director of Opelika Parks and Recreation. "New players are always welcome. We offer them tips and advice, and we invite them to play in games. Most people play with everyone and teams change regularly."

There does not seem to be an age limit on the sport. There are several players in their 20's and the oldest regular player is in his 80's. It is certainly popular with senior adults, but the vast majority of Opelika's players are ages 40-55.

"This sport is the best sport ever," said Soule. "It brings so much happiness to people who have bad knees, bad hips, or who are older or overweight.




People who are athletes, former athletes and people who have never played sports in their life can play pickleball. I can't even begin to say what this sport has meant to people." For more information about the




